Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages God's Chastening – The Importance of YOUR Soul! What should be our response to this discipline? 1. The child of God must not despise it! 2. We must not faint under the impact of it! 3. We must submit to it! (O Lord, may thy will, not mine, be done!) 4. Strive for the deepening and maturing of our faith under the chastening!

Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages God's Chastening – The Importance of YOUR Soul! C.S. Lewis once wrote: "God whispers to us in our pleasures, speaks to us in our conscience, but shouts to us in our pains: it is His megaphone to rouse a deaf world!"

Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages God's Chastening – The Importance of YOUR Soul! A survey was conducted and asked people this question: What would you ask if you were given the opportunity to ask God just one question? The #1 answer: Why is there so much suffering the world? The #2 answer: Why do bad things happen to

good people?

Luke 22:31-34 <sup>31</sup> "Simon, Simon, behold, Satan has demanded *permission* to sift you like wheat; <sup>32</sup> but I have prayed for you, that your faith may not fail; and you, when once you have turned again, strengthen your brothers." <sup>33</sup> But he said to Him, "Lord, with You I am ready to go both to prison and to death!" 34 And He said, "I say to you, Peter, the rooster will not crow today until you have denied three times that you know Me."

<sup>3</sup> For I know my transgressions, And my sin is ever before me.

Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages God's Chastening – The Importance of YOUR Soul! Solomon also gave great insight regarding the necessity of God's discipline! Proverbs 3:11-12 <sup>11</sup> My son, do not reject the discipline of the LORD Or loathe His reproof, <sup>12</sup> For whom the LORD loves He reproves, Proverbs 12:1 <sup>1</sup> Whoever loves discipline loves knowledge, But he who hates reproof is stupid.

Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages God's Chastening – The Importance of YOUR Soul! It is unquestionably a common theme throughout the **OT regarding the importance of God's discipline!** Here are examples from Moses and certainly, Job. **Deuteronomy 8:5-6** <sup>5</sup> Thus you are to know in your heart that the LORD your God was disciplining you just as a man disciplines his son. <sup>6</sup> Therefore, you shall keep the commandments of

the LORD your God, to walk in His ways and to fear Him.

*Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages* God's Chastening – The Importance of <u>YOUR</u> Soul! It is unquestionably a common theme throughout the OT regarding the importance of God's discipline! Here are examples from Moses and certainly, Job.

Job 5:17-18

<sup>17</sup> "Behold, how happy is the man whom God reproves, So do not despise the discipline of the Almighty.
<sup>18</sup> "For He inflicts pain, and gives relief; He wounds, and His hands *also* heal.

Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages God's Chastening – The Importance of YOUR Soul! **Our conclusions:** 1. There is an implication from the scriptures that persecution from evil-doers (because Christians are good rather than evil) is to be regarded as a form of divine discipline. (Matthew 10:22)

<sup>22</sup> You will be hated by all because of My name, but it is the one who has endured to the end who will be saved.

*Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages* God's Chastening – The Importance of <u>YOUR</u> Soul! Our conclusions (cont.):

2. God allows (not sends!) trials and persecutions to develop, mold, and mature our Christian character. (Lamentations 3:33)

3. Discipline is God's way to make "all things work out for good." (Romans 8:28)

*Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages* God's Chastening – The Importance of <u>YOUR</u> Soul! Our conclusions (cont.):

> 4. From our experiences of discipline, if we love God and do His will, we emerge strengthened, refined, and better fit for His purposes!

> 5. God's discipline is evidence we are his children. Far from being a reason for despair, it should rather be perceived as a foundation for encouragement! (Hebrews 12:7-8)

Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages God's Chastening – The Importance of YOUR Soul! Our conclusions (cont.): 6. Remember, Jesus suffered far more than we will ever be asked to endure. This must stand as our greatest encouragement to not become weary in our trials! (Matthew 20:18-19) <sup>18</sup> "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem; and the Son of Man will be delivered to the chief priests and scribes, and they will condemn Him to death, <sup>19</sup> and will hand Him over to the Gentiles to mock and scourge and crucify *Him*, and on the third day He will be raised up."

*Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages* God's Chastening – The Importance of <u>YOUR</u> Soul! Our conclusions (cont.):

7. We must endeavor to learn to recognize suffering and persecution as corrective and instructive training in our spiritual development as the children of a loving God! (Revelation 3:19)

*Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages* God's Chastening – The Importance of <u>YOUR</u> Soul! Our conclusions (cont.):

8. There are three principle objectives involved which outline the purpose of chastening:
a. Correcting our faults!
b. Strengthening our faith!
c. Stimulating our eternal welfare!

Difficult and Hard to Understand Passages God's Chastening – The Importance of YOUR Soul! Our conclusions (continued): 9. Finally, let us not forget that we were promised to *never* be tempted beyond what we are able to resist. The discipline of God will <u>never</u> be more than we can tolerate! (I Corinthians 10:13) <sup>13</sup> No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.
