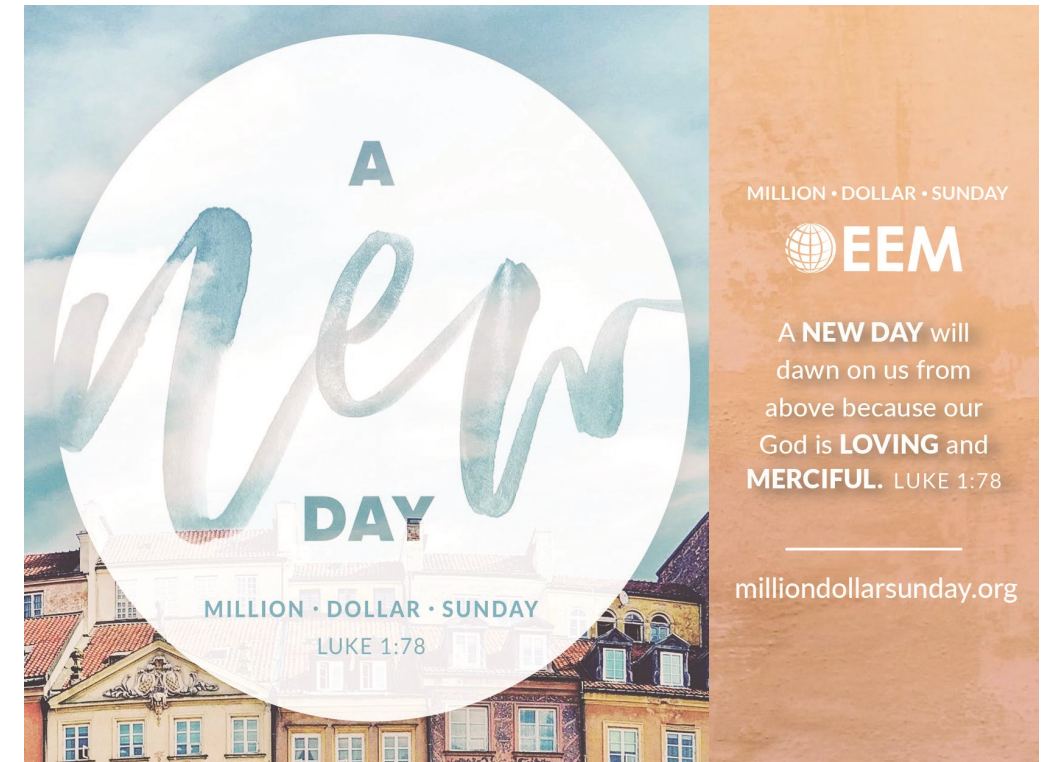

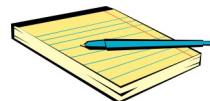


## The Bible. We Want Everyone To Get It.

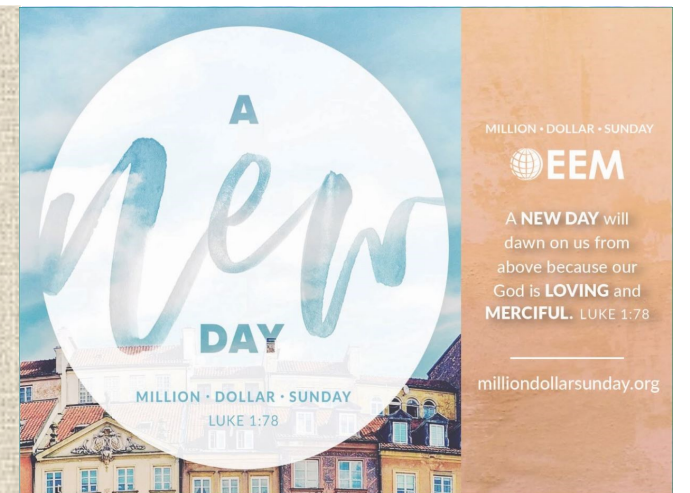
