



# LIFE RENOVATION

Back on July 19, we began a journey together through the Sermon on the Mount. We will complete that series this week. I pray that it has been both a blessing and a challenge to you. The teachings of Jesus in Matthew 5-7 may seem simple on the surface, but putting them into practice has been a challenge for generations of His followers. Even though it can be difficult to live up to these ideals, we must take on the challenge daily to live like Jesus in an upside-down world.

As we work on our life renovation, let me encourage you in a few ways with the sermon itself and ways we can grow from it.

- 1. Study the sermon. Read Matthew 5-7 periodically. Our lives would benefit from reading the Sermon on the Mount monthly or even weekly. It's a small time commitment to be regularly reminded of these important teachings.
- 2. Be an example. When Jesus compares His followers to a "city on a hill" in Matthew 5:14. When we live out the teachings of Jesus, we are the kind of light He wants us to be.
- 3. Do these things. In Matthew 7:24, Jesus says that wisdom comes from hearing and doing. Don't let the Sermon on the Mount be an interesting, familiar set of teachings that do not change you. Put them into action.
