## All To Us

In January I introduced you to the theme for our Sunday morning lessons this year, "All to Us." The lyrics by Chris Tomlin connect with many themes from scripture (Colossians 2:9-10, Colossians 3:11, Acts 4:11-12 and much of the book of Hebrews). My hope was to emphasize that Jesus is sufficient for us. The plan for 2020 began by looking at His life in the gospel of John. Learning from the prayers of Jesus is another way to remind ourselves that He is all to us.
