My family moved to Mobile, Alabama on the Gulf Coast a month before my 6th birthday. Less than two weeks after that birthday, Mobile experienced the worst hurricane in the city's history. Our family sat in the hallway throughout the night listening to the news on a transistor radio when we could hear it over the sound of a glass patio door rattling with the wind and rain. When we went outside the next morning, we saw several trees down including one through a neighbor's roof. We were without power and water for nearly two weeks. After that storm, we kept a hurricane box in the house. There were batteries, flashlights, candles, water and some other items. We would be ready for the aftermath of another storm. Although I left hurricanes behind long ago, I went into our storm shelter just last week to clean out cobwebs and crickets, check the door and latch and make sure the supplies are in order. In Oklahoma, our storm preparation looks a little different, but the principle is still the same as the Boy Scout motto: be prepared.

In Mark 13, Jesus warns his disciples to be prepared, because the time of his return will be unknown. He warns them and us to live lives that are ready for that day. He knew then what we witness today. Too many people instead live with a plan to get everything together somewhere down the road. They plan to overcome that sin later. There are relationships they plan to mend later. They plan to forgive later. They plan to have a better relationship with God later. They plan to tell that friend or family member about Christ later. We can't keep waiting for later. Let's be prepared every day.
