The Wednesday night class for  $K-5^{th}$  grade is designed to reinforce Bible basics. We will be working on memorizing selected verses, the books of the Bible, the 10 Commandments, the steps of salvation, activities during worship service, the apostles, the fruit of the spirit, and days of creation. As these are mastered, more items will be added.

Along with memorization work, we will have a lesson designed to strengthen the students' faith and increase basic Biblical knowledge. These are some of the topics: "What is God like?", "Who is Jesus?", "Why is church important?", "Why should I study the Bible?", and "I'm a Christian, but I still sin-what can I do about it?".

The students' progress will be tracked on a chart kept in class. The information memorized must be recited during 3 to 5 different class times to be considered mastered and a point credited. Once a student reaches 12 points, a gift card to Sonic will be awarded for their diligence.
