

NEWS FROM UKRAINE

(Excerpts from an update on Tuesday, May 3)

Hello, how are you?!

Thank God we are alive! The situation in our city is getting worse. Roundups on men are intensifying. The second wave of forced mobilization continues. In order to make it impossible to pay off for money or through acquaintances, the military was sent from the neighboring Donetsk region.... During the day they go knocking on doors and windows. At night, they check those houses in which the door has not been opened. If there is light in the windows in these houses, then they knock out the door and conduct searches. Therefore, for the third month now, we have not used lighting, turned off the street lamp and everything that could attract attention. Public service workers were attached to the military, who took the men away. They go around houses and apartments "check meters". If you open the door for them, they hand out summonses. We have already come this kind of "Trojan horse". We didn't open the door....

We continue to hold worship services. Despite the dangers. Adult brothers and sisters manage to get to us, who at the moment are not subject to conscription into the army. We cannot pick up everyone by car, as before. We are very encouraged by the family from our neighboring town: sister V and brother V. Their son is also hiding - fearing mobilization. They come to us despite the restrictions. Intercity transport between our cities has been reduced to one bus. We had to change the time of worship due to the schedule of this bus. We ask you to pray for our brother, so that the Lord hides him from the military, and he does not fall under mobilization....

We are very grateful to you for your love, prayers and help. Please convey our greetings and gratitude to all the brothers and sisters in your congregation for their love and prayers. Thank you very much for your letters of encouragement. We may not always read them on time, but they inspire us. I would like to highlight a verse from the psalm you sent. "For the rod of the wicked shall not rest upon the lot of the righteous; lest the righteous put forth their hands unto iniquity." (Psalms 125:3) This is a very accurate psalm. We have committed our lives to the Lord. And we have one hope in Him. We hope that our Lord will save us in this war and we will stay alive. Thank you for everything!


