

KEEPING YOUR HEAD

Recently I have been rereading one of my favorite recent books, *The Gift of Ministry* by Mike Ireland. It's a unique experience to read a book about ministry that is written by someone I did ministry with for almost a decade. The chapter I read today begins with 1 Timothy 4:5 in the NIV where Paul encourages Timothy to "keep your head in all situations." Sometimes that can be easier said than done, but Mike gives some great ideas to help us to keep our heads. Although he is writing with ministers in minds, I believe these are truths that can benefit any Christian.

"First, spend time with good people. Surround yourself with those who seem able to navigate through life's tempestuous moments while, at the same time, encouraging others. Observe them, question them, and learn from them. Find out what enables them to remain calm, but alert, and sensible and controlled when the situation changes and others seem to be heating up. Learn as much as you can from those who have made the journey before you.

Second, fill yourself up with God's Word. If you want His way and words to be in evidence no matter the situations of life, then you must be full of Him. "Living Beyond Your Feelings," "Stop Overreacting," and "Managing Your Emotions" are just a few of the hundreds of titles you will find in local bookshops. All claim to possess the answer to how to bring your life under control. But the best book for learning how to think straight and live right is the Bible!

Third, keep your eyes fixed on Jesus. Remember that the goal of ministry is not winning the arguments or driving off the opposition and it is not avoiding the problems or being free of any adversity. The goal of ministry is to glorify the Lord by serving His people and that is impossible if you look away from Jesus. No matter the situation in which you find yourself, the aim is to honor the Lord. Do not lose sight of him!"

Good companions, God's word and the best Teacher and Example are all keys to keeping our heads in any situation. - Brian
