Historically in churches of Christ, we have not paid much attention to religious holidays that are on the calendar. Their observance is not a command in scripture, but there are many that are still familiar to us. Two of the most prominent religious holidays that have survived centuries of change in our world are Christmas and Easter. If you still have a paper calendar somewhere, they are likely indicated on those days. Even in a culture that might not acknowledge Jesus the other 363 days each year, there is a little more awareness of Him on those 2 days.

The birth and resurrection of Jesus are time that are filled with hope. They are evidence of the sovereignty of God. They are displays of His power. They are proof of His plan. But before there can be a resurrection, there has to be a death. That is a day that feels hopeless. It is a time that seems unjust. Followers turn on Jesus. There is excitement. There are endless possibilities. The future is bright. Death is the opposite. There is a finality. Time has run its course. It's hard not to think that way. It must have been difficult for that confused group who followed Jesus. Unlike them, we know that chapter 16 is coming and that everything is about to change forever. Jesus knew that he would have to suffer the mockery, beatings and death of Mark chapter 15 even before He even came here as that baby in the manger. But He came anyway. And His story did not stop there. Death gave way to life. Death still gives way to new life today. That new life is a reason to celebrate everyday!




