One of my favorite questions that I've read in recent years was from the book *Practicing the Way*: "Are we becoming more loving?" As Christians, we should always be increasing in love. Former Chicago Bear, Mike Singletary, is a powerful motivational speaker. He said that every night before he goes to bed, he looks into the mirror and asks himself one question:

"Did you get better today?"

Is there anything you left undone today? Is there someone whom you need to call and apologize? Do you need to tell someone "thank you" for being in your life. This really got my attention as I think about my own life. I have been thinking about this question ever since I heard him say it.

"Did you get better today?"

As Singletary suggests, some days I need to apologize. Some days I need to confess that I have complained way too much. On other days, I need to focus more on saying "Thank you" to the people who have made a difference in my life.

Far too many of us go through a day and focus on our scarcity:

- If only I had more money.
- If only my spouse would do better.
- If only I had a better job.
- If only the kids would straighten up.
- If only others might recognize my value.

Far too many people end the day with "If only . . ." Yet, ending the day like this invites blaming, projecting, and perhaps jealousy. I like the question, "Did you get better today?" This invites you and me to take responsibility, be intentional, and to focus on our growth. I want to shaped more into the image of Jesus each day. I want my day to reflect this.

What do you ask when you look into the mirror?

"But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror." - James 1:22-23
