

REMINDERS

With a title like that, I should probably clarify that this is not going to be an article about reminders of upcoming church events or important dates. You can find those on the following pages. We're actually going to talk about reminders. Whether you are old school and use post-it notes or more current and use an app (or someone like my wife who uses both), we can all use reminders from time to time. The people who Paul writes to in the New Testament are no different.

In his letter to Titus, Paul begins the third chapter by telling Titus to "Remind them" then lists several things that the Christians Titus is ministering to need to remember. We do too.

- "Be submissive to rulers and authorities, to be obedient." (Titus 3:1) Christians should be good citizens who respect authority. This had to be an especially challenging teaching when considering the Roman government's animosity toward the church.
- "Be ready for every good work." (Titus 3:1) Paul understood that goodness in the lives of God's people would help prepare the soil for the spread of God's message.
- "Speak evil of no one." (Titus 3:2) Words matter, and we should choose kind and positive ones when speaking about others.
- "Avoid quarreling." (Titus 3:2) Many of our arguments are trivial and avoidable. When we
 find ourselves involved in a quarrel, we can choose to deescalate the situation and seek a
 peaceful resolution.
- "Be gentle." (Titus 3:2) In our culture, gentleness is most often used to describe animals and children. Scripture speaks frequently of gentleness among adults. It is a character trait (and fruit of the Spirit) that we should embrace daily.
- "Show perfect courtesy toward all people." (Titus 3:2) The Greek word interpreted "courtesy" in the ESV connotes gentleness, humility and meekness. This is how Jesus lived in His interactions with others.

The Expositor's Bible Commentary concludes that these verses are a reminder of how we should interact with others. "In this way, believers will make sure that the only offense is that of the gospel; carelessness of speech, argumentativeness, and arrogance must not stand in the way." Our conversations and interactions with others could influence their desire to learn more about the good news of Jesus. Let's make the most of every opportunity to share the love of Jesus.
